

## **Product Warranty**

TiLux™ sold by Midwest LED corporation warrants its products against defects in material and workmanship for three years. During the warranty period, the Company will repair or replace (as its option) any parts or electronic assemblies of the unit which disclose a defect in material or workmanship. The Company will return the repaired unit, transportation cost prepaid. Return Material authorization is required for returning Midwest LED products for warranty consideration. Each Midwest LED product sold is covered by the official warranty in effect at time of purchase.

This warranty is between the end customer (ultimate user) and LED folio (manufacturer). Manufacturer's warranty does not cover damage due to improper installation, abuse, neglect, or any other failure due to out of ordinary and reasonable consumer use. Midwest LED will not be held liable for any incidental or consequential damages, and assumes no responsibility or liability for expenses incurred in the removal and/or reinstallation of products requiring service and/or repair; nor the packaging, handling, and shipping to Midwest LED; nor for the handling of products returned from the Company after service or repair. There are no other warranties, expressed or implied, including, but not limited to, any implied merchantability or fitness for a particular use. This warranty will be void when using or substituting other than all-genuine Midwest LED system components such as the power supply. Warranties are not transferable.

## **Owner/User Responsibilities**

It is the responsibility of the contractor, installer, purchaser, owner, and user to install, maintain, and operate TiLux™ in such a manner as to comply with all state and local laws, ordinances, regulations, and the American National Standards Institute Safety Code.

## **Identification and Warnings of Safety Hazards**

In accordance with ANSI Z535.4-2002 the following system of identifying the severity of the hazards associated with the products is used:

**“DANGER”** Imminently hazardous situation which, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.

**“WARNING”** Potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in death or serious injury.

**“CAUTION”** Potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury or property damage. Also used to alert against unsafe practices.

**WARNING:** Ensure that main power supply is off before installing or wiring TiLux™.

**WARNING:** TiLux™ must be installed by a qualified electrician in accordance with NEC and relevant local codes.

**WARNING:** Do not use TiLux™ if the power cables are damaged.

**WARNING:** Do not attempt to install or use TiLux™ until you read and understand the installation instructions and safety labels.

**CAUTION:** Do not exceed the specified voltage and current input.

**CAUTION:** Do not exceed the maximum number of specified fixtures in a light run. Doing so will result in current overload.

**CAUTION:** Do not hot swap. Ensure that power to the fixture is off before connecting or disconnecting fixtures.
